Students will present social justice projects on important issues in our society that they have been developing during MEMA-Music's arts-integrated global education program.

During the program, students examined the impact of popular music in social and political movements throughout history and today, and watched related videos—including clips chronicling the Vietnam War protests, the Civil Rights movement, and current protests / marches. Students analyzed and reflected on messages presented in song lyrics about morals, politics, injustice and social change, to investigate different perspectives and express their own views about the world today.
