

Friends of Stone Academy meeting minutes from October 10, 2017 meeting

Teju suggested a survey of the school to see what type of cuisine they would like for future restaurant fundraisers.

Aimee reported on the Gift Cards for Kids fundraiser. Gift card orders were due October 2nd. A co-chair is still needed to work with Bernadette this year to learn the gift card system and take over the following year.

Aimee reported on the Lynch Creek Farm fundraiser. Lynch Creek will donate 20% sales of fall and holiday wreaths and centerpieces. It started October 1st and will go through December 17th. It has raised \$34 so far.

Aimee reported on the Improv Tonight fundariser. It is scheduled for November 4, 2017 at Bughouse Theater. Social hour will be from 6:30-7:30 pm and the show will be from 7:30-9:00 pm. Tickets are \$35 each or 2 for \$60. Tickets will be \$40 after November 3rd at 3:00 pm. The event is adults only and BYOB. Aimee asked for co-chairs for the event. Andrea volunteered to co-chair and will try to find another co-chair.
