Students will present social justice projects on important issues in our society that they have been developing during MeMA-Music's arts-integrated, civics education program.

During the program, students examined the impact of popular music in social and political movements throughout history, in particular the 60s-70s—a decade that changed America—and today, and watched related videos—including clips chronicling the Vietnam War student protests, the Civil Rights Movement, and current protests and marches. Students analyzed and reflected on messages presented in song lyrics about morals, politics, injustice and social change, to investigate how to create a peaceful message for equality and justice by expressing **their own views** about the world today.

Some of the topics covered in student projects include racism, feminism, Islamophobia, political polarization, depression, violence and more.
